- Available for EAHM undergraduate and postgraduate programmes

Hospitality Industry Scholarship

- Available for EAHM undergraduate and postgraduate programmes
- 10% on tuition fees for each academic term
- Applicable to employees, dependent employees, and spouses of hotels, restaurants, and tourism companies

- Terms & Conditions apply

Other scholarships

United Arab Emirates National (UAEN) Scholarship

- UAE nationals will receive a 30% scholarship for all academic terms. Applicable for any programme. Terms & Conditions apply.

Emirati ESAAD card holders

- 35% scholarship for all Emirati card holders
- 20% scholarship for all non-Emirati card holders
- 25% scholarship for non-Emirati card holders with a cumulative average 80% or 3.2/4.0 CGPA
- 30% scholarship for non-Emirati card holders with a cumulative average 90% or 3.6/4.0 CGPA

Non-Emirati ESAAD card holders

- Cardholders and immediate family members are eligible for a scholarship between 20%-30% for all academic terms. The exact scholarship entitlement depends on the grades (CGPA) of the applicant. Applicable for any EAHM programme. Terms & Conditions apply.

Alumni Scholarship

- Any EAHM alumnus of a bachelor-level programme is offered a 50% scholarship for all academic terms when joining the postgraduate programme. Any EAHM alumnus of the Study Abroad programme is offered a 25% scholarship for all academic terms when joining a postgraduate programme. Terms & Conditions apply.

Jumeirah Colleagues Scholarship

- Colleagues, spouses or children will be offered a 50% scholarship for all academic terms. Applicable for any EAHM programmes. Terms & Conditions apply.

Sibling Scholarship

- Applicable for any EAHM programme at 10% for each academic term. The scholarship will be applied for siblings of current or past students. Terms & Conditions apply.

Terms & Conditions

- Scholarships are non-cumulative (exception: Early Bird Discount)
- Scholarships apply to full-time tuition fees only. No scholarship can be granted against accommodation, meal plan, or additional or administrative charges.
- Scholarships cannot be granted retroactively.
- Scholarships for new students, once granted, remain valid for the whole duration of their studies, and will apply
- for each academic term. No re-application is required.
- If students are granted a scholarship, they must not have an outstanding balance on their student account during
- their studies. In case of payment arrears, EAHM reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship and place the
- student on financial and academic hold.
- EAHM reserves the right to review and modify the Scholarship policy at any time and without notice.

Conditions for keeping the Scholarships

- Once granted to the recipient, the scholarship is kept throughout the course of studies provided the following conditions:
Academic achievements stated in the “Validity” section
- Service to the institution as an Ambassador, as mentioned in the Scholarship Letter.
- The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and cannot be appealed.
