PURPOSE:

This policy defines the role of the Industry Advisory Board and its relationship to EAHM.

SCOPE:

It defines the activities of the Industry Advisory board, its scope in terms of areas of advice and comment and building industry relationships via research, consultancy, collaboration and student internships, and specifically refers to its relationship with EAHM via the International Relations and Global Mobility Department, which acts as liaison.

DEFINITIONS:

Internship: the position of a student or trainee who works in an organization, sometimes without pay, in order to gain work experience or satisfy requirements for a qualification

Collaboration: is the process of two or more individuals working together to complete a task or achieve a common objective. Effective collaboration necessitates interpersonal skills, communications skills, knowledge sharing, and coordination.

POLICY STATEMENT:

The Industry Advisory Board comprises of industry representatives from a variety of related sectors and supports EAHM by acting as a think tank addressing industry relevant issues and offering advice on a variety of industry / academic matters.

The advisory board shall have at least six members with at least two members each from industry and academia and one representative from the International Relationship and Global Mobility Department at EAHM.

EAHM will invite participants to join the Industry Advisory Board and each member shall have a term of 2 years and may be invited for a further two years of membership at the discretion of EAHM.

The activities of the Industry Advisory Board *inter alia* are as follows:

- To establish dialogue between the institution and professional community.
- To advise on updating curriculum in accordance with contemporary advancements and needs in the industry.
- To guide in new program development related to the specific regional needs
- To guide the institute in developing partnerships for internship and placement opportunities
- To help in achieving strategic growth of the institution

The members of the advisory Board shall function with the highest levels of integrity, honesty and ethical behavior in all decision making. The members of the advisory board shall comply with policies 10LP01: Conflict of Interest and 10LP02 Anti-corruption and Bribery.

The performance of the Industry Advisory Board is evaluated annually by EAHM using a prescribed

survey and set of questions. The survey is managed by the Quality Assurance Unit and a performance report is distributed to the EAHM Managing Director, International Relationships and Global Mobility Department and the Industry Advisory Board. The Managing Director takes necessary action for meaningful and effective engagement of the Advisory Board.
