Over the 1.5-year duration, students have the flexibility to select elective courses, enabling them to focus on specific areas of interest such as Hospitality Entrepreneurship, Sustainable Destination Management, Designing Unique Experiences, Tech Transformation & Innovation, and Advanced F&B Operations. Classes are scheduled in the evenings from Monday to Thursday, empowering students to pursue daytime work commitments and apply their acquired knowledge directly to their studies.

Wine and Spirit Education Trust Qualification

The Wine and Spirit Education Trust provides industry leading qualifications in wines since 1969. WSET has grown to become the global industry leader and international standard in wine and spirit education. These classes help develop comprehensive product knowledge and tasting skills, using the unique WSET Systematic Approach to Tasting (SAT).

WSET Level 1

A beginner level introduction to wine suitable for those starting a wine career or pursuing an interest in wine. For individuals new to wine study, this qualification provides a hands-on introduction to the world of wine. You will explore the main types and styles of wine through sight, smell, and taste, while also gaining the basic skills to describe wines accurately and make food and wine pairings. Upon successful completion, you will receive a WSET certificate and lapel pin.

WSET Level 2

WSET's Level 2 Award in Wines is a beginner-to-intermediate level qualification exploring wines, suitable for industry professionals and wine enthusiasts. This qualification is intended for beginners wishing to learn about a wide range of wines or those seeking to build on the introductory knowledge gained with the WSET Level 1 Award in Wines. You will gain knowledge of the principal and regionally important grape varieties of the world, the regions in which they are grown, and the styles of wine they produce.

Through a combination of tasting and theory, you will explore the factors that impact style and quality and learn how to describe these wines with confidence.

Certified Hospitality Supervisor (CHS®)

This 5-day course provides recognition for skills such as leadership, time management, and communication. The CHS designation is the lodging industry's highest acknowledgement of professionalism for supervisors in the hospitality industry.

Finance Awareness for Non-Financial Managers

This programme provides delegates with an opportunity to update their financial skills and gain a better understanding of the planning and control processes in a commercial service organisation. Each delegate will have an opportunity to translate their learning directly into the workplace with case studies and scenarios based on real business problems and solutions.
